Student Parliament will be recruiting 5 elected officers or academic representatives to be part of the scrutiny panel.

This means that the paid elected leaders

- Welfare/International Student Leader (24 Hours)
- Education/ International Student Leader (24 Hours)
- Trans/ LGBTQ+ Leader (9 hours plus additional)
- Women's Leader
- BAME Leader
- Disability Leader

Will all be held to account by students on a panel.

This panel will be made up of elected Student Parliament Members!

5 Panel members will receive leader reports which they will then get to question and review.

The Panel will then give elected leaders a score and verbal recommendations, which goes as follows:

- Commendation -For elected leaders who have shown exceptional work.
- Satisfaction For elected leaders who have shown satisfactory work.
- Concern For elected leaders who have not met the exceptions/requirements of their role.
- No Confidence This can be given to an elected officer, who has already received a concern grading.
